General members have full voting rights, and those who are members of a First Nation are eligible to be Directors of the Society.

Dues for General Members: Membership in the Society becomes effective upon the date full payment of dues and completed application are received, and ends on March 31st of the current fiscal year. FNESS' fiscal year runs from April 1st to March 31st.
