Position Summary:

The Youth Summer Student team member will prioritize Indigenous Knowledge while supporting the Decision Support Manager in developing, coordinating, promoting, and administering technology-driven, community-focused support. This entry level position requires the ability to communicate and work with other team members on various special projects. On occasion, and in a safe manner, opportunities for field experience may be available.

Position Responsibilities:

- Orientation & Training.
 - Learn about FNESS Programs & Services.
 - Beginners Emergency Management Training.
 - Introduction to Decision Support Tools and Technology
- Data entry and mapping project based on individual skills and FNESS business needs.
- Assist the Decision Support Manager or designated team lead with other FNESS programs and services as requested.
- Utilize the FNESS decisions support tools to collect, analyze, map and report on different data sets to assist First Nations communities.
- Support FNESS staff with data collection and training as required.
- Provide weekly written project updates to the Decision Support Manager
- Support the development of new forms, reports, workflows, and business processes using FNESS decision support tools.
- Collect feedback and suggest improvements for the Decision Support Team.
- Assist the Decision Support Manager or designated team lead with program reports for internal and external purposes.
- Assist in promoting Decision Support and other FNESS department programs.

Position Requirements:

- Lived experience with First Nations people and communities.

- Excited to learn about, Integrated and use new innovative technologies to help First Nations Communities with Emergency Management.
- Interest in one, or more of the following categories will be helpful:
