For Students

Kitchen Safety Activity

This activity teaches children the importance of identifying hazards in the kitchen, and the potential sources of fires. By recognizing these hazards, children can effectively communicate the dangers to a parent or caregiver.

Recommendation: Provide a copy of the activity sheet to each child. This activity can be done individually, in pairs, or as a class. Review responses when complete using the answer key provided as a guide.

Kitchen Safety Quiz

This quiz serves as a teaching tool for simple kitchen safety and behaviours.

Recommendation: Use the quiz as a class activity to promote discussion and ensure understanding of correct responses. An answer key has been provided.

For Families

Cooking Safety Handout (Poster)

This family Cooking Safety Handout highlights the fire related dangers surrounding cooking and the importance of paying attention to cooking safety practices. Adults play a significant leadership role in this regard to ensure they and their families are safe.
