
4. You get a bowl of soup for lunch and there is steam rising from the soup. You should...

1. A grown-up is at the stove, you should...



Stand far away from them.

- Give the grown-up some space to safely cook.
- If you need help or attention, use your voice.

2. A safe place to play is...



In your safe play area away from the stove.

• Grown-ups can help to find a safe play area like the kitchen table, or a play space that is close to the kitchen.

3. You go to the coffee shop and get a hot chocolate. You should...



Ask an adult to make sure it's not too hot.

- A grown-up can taste the hot chocolate before you drink it.
- You can wait a few minutes to let it cool down.
- You can add some cold milk or water.

4. You get a bowl of soup for lunch and there is steam rising from the soup. You should...



Ask an adult to put some ice cubes in it.

• Ice cubes will cool the soup very quickly.

5. If you burn your skin, you should...



Cool it under cool water for 10-15 minutes.


- Put your burned skin under the tap with cool water or put water in a container and wait for 10-15 minutes.
- You can then put a nice dry bandage on the burn.

ACTIVITY SHEET - ANSWER KEY

- 1. Dad is trying to get something out of the toaster, and it's plugged in. He could get hurt from the electricity.
- 2. Mom is on the phone and not paying attention to what's going on in the kitchen.
- 3. **Baby is playing by the hot stove, and nobody is paying attention.** Baby could get burned if she touches the stove.
- 4. **Food is cooking on the stove and the pot handles are sticking out.** Baby could stand up and pull the pots down and get burned.
- 5. **Curtain is blowing over the stove and could catch on fire**. Close the window or tie back the curtain.
- 6. **Paper towels are too close to the stove.** Move the paper towel roll away from the stove.
- 7. There are too many plugs in the socket. This could start a fire.
- 8. **Cat playing with the dangling cord.** This would knock over the got tea kettle. The cord looks like it has been chewed and could start a fire.
- 9. **Hot cup of tea at the edge of the counter.** This could be knocked over and hurt the baby or cat.
- 10. **Knife on the edge of the counter.** This could be knocked over and hurt the baby or cat.

Additional problems in the kitchen:

- Open cupboards
- Tea towel hanging beside the stove and could catch on fire
- Garbage could spill onto the floor and cause slips and trips
- Rag is a tripping hazard
